- A brief summary of a topic for an absent classmate on a topic studied in class (audio or written text), including your opinion of the topic. (2 or 3 sentences only)

Criterion D: Using language in spoken and written form

Students will write a speech in which they use rhetoric to persuade their audience on a matter of social justice. Research will be done in class and at home, and the speech will be hand-written, using research notes and a pre-planned outline. The assessment will culminate in delivery of the speech.
