

Literature book: King Lear

- To develop students' ability to compare preferences
- To develop students' ability to retell a complex story
- Students will be able to identify and use literary devices
- Students will start to explore the old English culture in the Shakespearian era
- Strengthen students reading & comprehension skills
- By the end of the quarter students should be able to read and understand the Shakespearian language

Grammar:

- Review of Verb tenses
- Present- simple, Present- continuous, and Present- perfect

Vocabulary:

- 75% of words will come from the book, "*King Lear*"
- 25% of the words will be words of interest from the students/teacher

Reading:

- Students will have 3 sources of reading
 - o The class book, "*King Lear*"
 - o Achieve3000 twice a cycle
 - o Library book for leisure reading

Writing:

- Complete a 40 page (size a5) book
