We would like students to keep on working at improving their Reading Skills especially, and have suggested a few websites below to help students.

English: Students are to find books to read on-line for Holiday Reading. (Try www.scholastic.com; www.allyoucanbooks.com/ebooks/unlimited; www.magickeys.com/books; <https://freekidsbooks.org>; <https://readingeggs.co.nz/kids-books-online>)

Math: Revise Place value, Rounding whole numbers to the nearest to 10s 100s and 1000s, Simple Addition and Subtraction, revise the tables daily, Multiplication **Test on Monday 17 December, 2018.**

Students should be able to know their **multiplication tables up to 10**. They should also be able to do multiplication based on repeated addition

Examples:

$$2 \times 4 = 8$$

$$2 + 2 + 2 + 2 = 8$$

$$8 \times 3 = 24$$

$$8 + 8 + 8 = 24$$

Science: Revise all work for Terms 1 and 2.

What is a Life Cycle? Life cycle seen in different animals like Butterfly, Lady Bug, A plant and so on.

What are the basic things required for a plant to grow?

Different parts of a plant and its functions



What is migration? What is population?
What is a habitat?
